



NEW AW139 FOR HELI SHUTTLE AT LONDON BIGGIN HILL AIRPORT

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The London Heli Shuttle, operated by Castle Air at London Biggin Hill Airport , is extending its fleet to 10 helicopters with the addition of a new AgustaWestland AW139.
