The project has been approved by the Aruba DCA, and the certificate should be issued early June 2016. The first aircraft to be bridged on the Aruba AOC is P4-BBJ, probably one of the most beautiful BBJ on the market.

With an extended range of 5500 Nm, the P4-BBJ stylish wide cabin can accommodate 18 passengers in comfort and luxury, featuring a forward bedroom, 2 lounge areas, 2 bathrooms with showers and an office.
