



WOMEN IN CORPORATE AVIATION CELEBRATES 25TH ANNIVERSARY AT NBAA-BACE

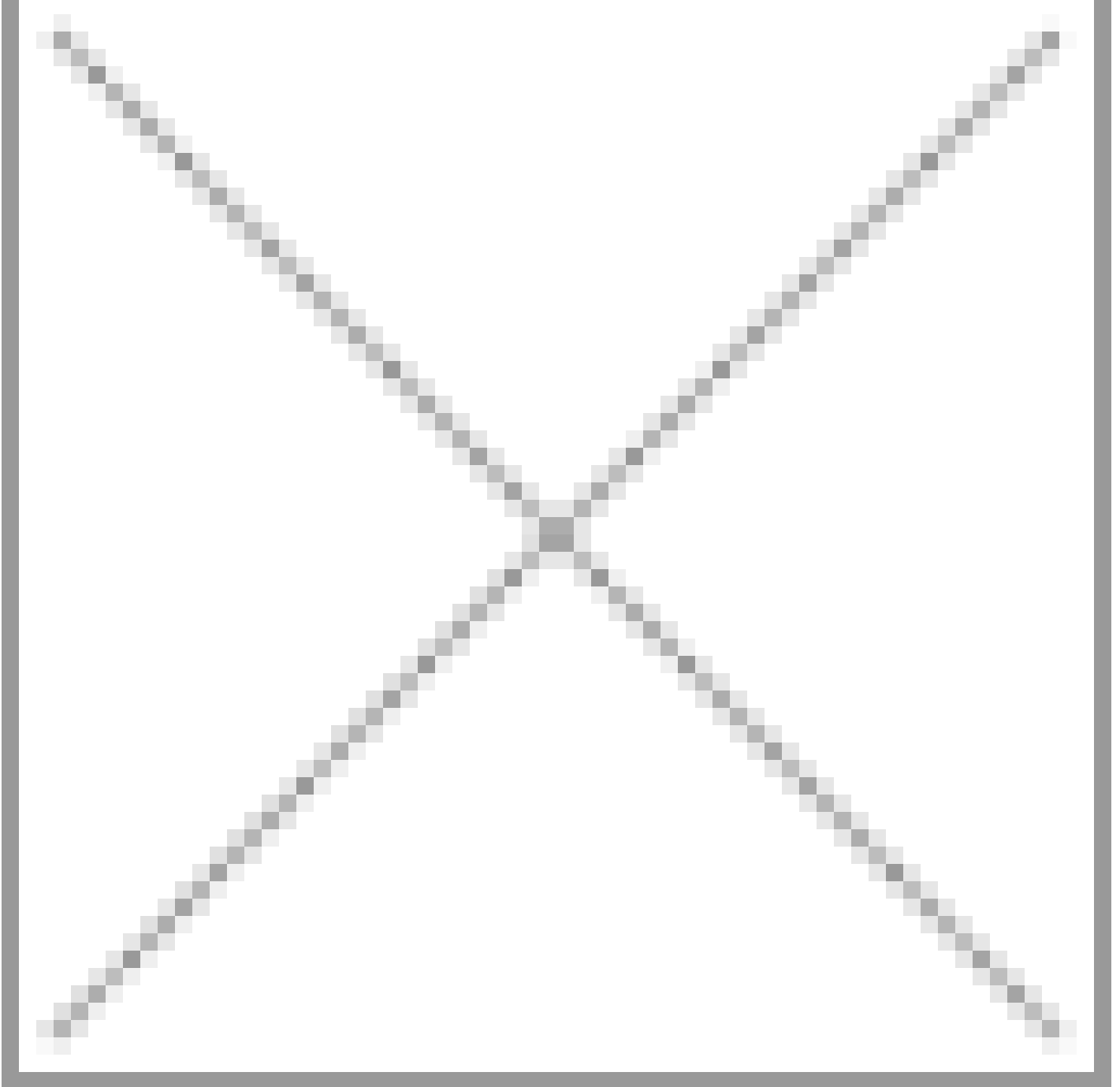
