



WIZZ AIR SECURES FINANCING FOR SIX AIRBUS A321CEOS

Fast-growing Hungarian low-cost carrier [Wizz Air](#) signed an agreement with China Development Bank's [CDB Leasing](#) to finance six Airbus A321neos. The deal includes the carrier's first two A321s scheduled for delivery later this year.

"We've developed a strong relationship with CDB Leasing as they continue to support our growth, now financing the first of our new A321s," CEO József Váradi said in a statement.

Terms of the agreement were not released.

Wizz Air takes delivery of its first [A321ceo](#) in November and its second in December. These aircraft are part of an existing order with Airbus.

Wizz Air recently confirmed a new order from Airbus for [110 new A321neo](#) aircraft, which will begin delivery in 2019, pending shareholder approval.

The carrier currently operates 63 180-seat A320s, six of which are also financed by CDB Leasing and were delivered in 2014-2015.

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
